

MedStar Health and Safety Policy

Face Covering Required

The virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread to others by infected persons who have few or no symptoms. Because of the hidden nature of this threat, it is the policy of MedStar to require the following:

- 1. FACE COVERING REQUIRED IN ORDER TO ENTER AND REMAIN ON PREMISES.** All persons over the age of ten (10), including employees and “Patrons” (defined as customers, visitors, invitees and contractors), who enter this premises must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth, such as a surgical mask, homemade mask, scarf, bandana, or handkerchief.
 - i. The requirement of a face covering does not apply if covering the nose and mouth poses a significant mental or physical health risk to the individual.
 - ii. The requirement of a face covering also does not apply when an individual is consuming a food or beverage.
- 2. SCREENING PROTOCOLS.** All persons entering the premises will be required to complete a COVID-19 Health Questionnaire, provide their contact information, and have their temperature taken by MedStar personnel to ensure they are not exhibiting any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
- 3. SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS.** Even with the use of appropriate face coverings, individuals should maintain six feet of social distancing whenever possible.
 - i. Employees should not work within six (6) feet of one another, except to the extent necessary to provide required services.
 - ii. Patrons should maintain six (6) feet of separation from other individuals to the extent feasible when inside the MedStar premises.
- 4. VIOLATIONS.** Patrons who do not wear a face covering will be asked to leave the MedStar premises and will not be provided services until the face covering, screening, and social distancing protocol requirements are followed.

MedStar reserves the right to exclude anyone from entering the premises based on the belief that the individual in MedStar’s sole opinion may be a threat or danger to public health and safety.
