

Janice A Knebl, DO, MBA, FACP, MACOI is the Dallas Southwest Osteopathic Physicians Endowed Chair in Clinical Geriatrics and University of North Texas System Regent's Tenured Professor, the Interim Chairman of the University of North Texas Health Science Center's Department of Internal Medicine and Geriatrics, the HSC Health Clinical Practice Group Interim Chief Medical Officer and the Principle Investigator for the Health Resources Services Administration's Geriatrics Workforce Enhancement Program entitled "Workforce Enhancement in Healthy Aging and Independent Living (WE HAIL)".

Dr Knebl has been a faculty member at UNTHSC since 1988 and established the Center for Older Adults that provides clinical care and services to older adults throughout the continuum of care within an ambulatory geriatrics clinic, house calls, assisted living and nursing facilities. She has specialized in care of persons with dementia diagnosis and support for their caregivers. Dr Knebl is the Medical Director for the JLWest Dementia Care Center and also the Stayton at Museum Way's skilled nursing, assisted living and memory care facilities.

She has been involved in medical student, resident and health professions student geriatrics education and the developer of innovative models of service-learning programs such as the Seniors Assisting in Geriatrics Education where health profession students participate in assessments on older adult volunteers in their homes. She was appointed to the MAEMSA Board of Directors by Mayor Betsy Price in fall of 2017 and currently the Chairman since 2021. Dr Knebl is passionate about in home care and the mobile health care and emergency services that the MedStar team members provide to the older adults in the community.
